The children started their day reading quietly, I spent a lot of the morning reading with the children outside the classroom, many of whom have moved on greatly with their reading abilities. There were a few children whose reading ability could be enhanced by their own willingness to read more at home, we discussed this together with the hope that they will endeavour to take more time at home to do this.

The literacy subject looked at 'inference' the children watched 'The Snowman' movie and were then required to write their own thoughts and ideas about the environment of the movie and the storyline. It was quite interesting to see their reactions and listen to their thoughts on the setting of the movie.

I had the opportunity to look at some of the children's writing and noted a marked improvement on their neatness, punctuation and expression.

The children then went on to do long multiplication, they were grouped according to their ability and support was offered by the teacher and assistant during this session. The children seemed to do very well.

The children have been given the opportunity to write poetry in the class RE book and to decorate their own poetry page. The book is beautifully decorated and

contains some extremely thoughtful reflections and heartwarming prayers for those in need and suffering around the world. What a lovely idea.
