Earrings, Hair and Uniform reminder

Our uniform and being smart is very important. We ask for your support in ensuring that the uniform policy is adhered to.

Earrings: We do discourage ear piercing during the academic year as the children are unable to participate in any PE activities until they are able to remove them independently. This is a legal requirement under Health and Safety. It is much better if they are pierced at the beginning of the summer holiday.

A reminder that any earrings worn should be **plain gold or silver studs** i.e. not diamantes or different shapes.

Hair: Girls with shoulder length hair and longer should tie their hair back from the face. Please remember that hair bands should be plain black or blue or in the school colours to match summer dresses later in the year. Boys' hair should be smart, not cover the eyes and hinder learning, be kept short and no longer than the collar. Tram lines and other extremes of fashion are not allowed.

Please ensure **all hats are in plain school colours or is a school hat** i.e. **not** furry animal ears, fancy muffs, ear muffs etc.... School hats are available from the school office at a cost of £4.70 each.

We are very short of tights, socks and both girl's and boy's underwear of every size in our spare clothing box. If you have any unwanted items at home that you no longer need, please send them in to us.
