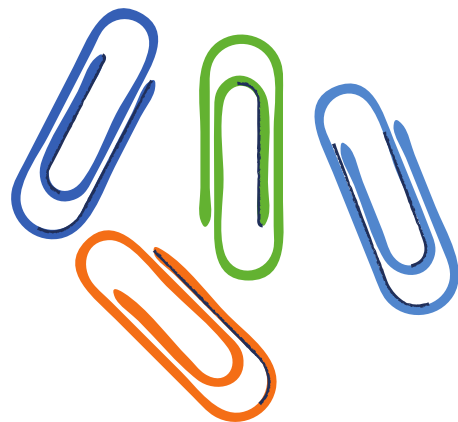
I am Mrs Tong and this is Year 3.

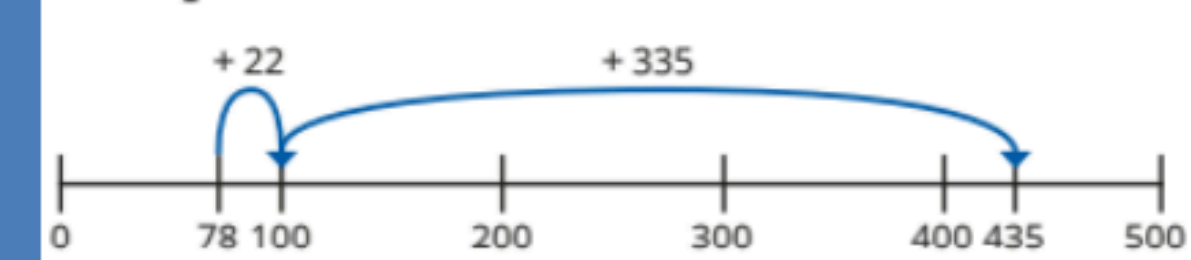

Requirement for Class

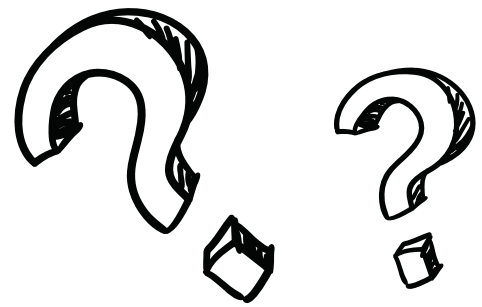
- Attendance matters and please try to be on time to minimise lost learning.
