Topic Children will learn about the layers of the rainforest and the animals that live their there. They will create images using water colours of a variety of wildlife indigenous to the rainforest.

English

Children will use their knowledge of the rainforest and deforestation to write a biased argument. They will also be taking inspiration from the book: Journey to the Last River, to create a variety of writing.

Science

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Children will learn about living things and their habitats considering how animals and plants are classified. They will also begin to think about how animals are suited to their environments. Term 4 and 5 How do the Rainforests Affect our World?
