

Literacy Key skills booster session 5

Constructing sentences

I would like you to use all the skills that we have been practising over the last few weeks to write some sentences of your own. If you need to, before you do, go back and watch the previous booster sessions to remind yourself what we have learnt about full stops, capital letters and making sure that sentences make sense.

Look at each image below and think about one sentence that you would like to write about it. It can simply be a sentence about what you see. Write one sentence for each picture. If you would like to write more than one sentence then that would be fantastic!

Steps to Success:

1. Look at the picture.
2. Think of a sentence about the picture.
3. Say your sentence aloud.
4. Think about what your first word is and write it down.
5. Read the word that you have written and check that it is the word that you were thinking of.
6. Say your sentence again.
7. Think about what your second word is and write it down.
8. Read what you have written to check.
9. Repeat these steps of thinking of your next word, writing it down and then checking what you have written until you have written the whole sentence.
